Serving teens and adults with developmental differences – that’s the motto of Potomac Community Resources.

Potomac Community Resources, an outreach of Our Lady of Mercy Catholic parish, provides high quality programs that are dynamic and innovative and that are requested by its members, the teenagers and adults with developmental differences who use the programs. PCR offers over 30 therapeutic, recreational, social, educational and respite care programs, such as music therapy, adult chorus, wheelchair dance class, adapted aerobics and photography.

Led by experienced professionals, staff and a hundred volunteers, these programs enable the members to grow in confidence, form friendships, gain healthy lifestyles and experience success. Some programs are drop-in, others run for consecutive months.

PCR is a small nonprofit promoting the inclusion into community life of teens and adults with developmental differences in Potomac and across the region. Founded in 1994 by a group of families at Our Lady of Mercy, PCR today serves hundreds of individuals and their families.
